Safety

For your personal safety, we ask that you exercise due care at all times. Remember to bring sun protection (lotion, hat, sunglasses) and a comfortable pair of shoes, or visit the Tampa General Hospital Sunscreen Stations for complimentary sunscreen. Please do not step under or over ropes. Never cross fairways except at designated cross-over areas. Please be sure to read the Assumption of Risk section located on your ticket and at ValsparChampionship.com.

First Aid and EMS Services

Provided by Tampa General Hospital and located by the 18th green. In the event of an accident or injury on the golf course, proceed to First Aid or contact a Gallery Marshal or Tournament Official with a radio. They will contact First Aid or EMS to assist you.

Severe Weather

The PGA TOUR® will monitor the weather daily during tournament week. In the event of thunderstorms, lightning or other severe weather. "Weather Warning" information will be displayed on the electronic scoreboards around the golf course. When these warnings appear, fans are advised to take precautions and seek shelter immediately. The electronic scoreboards will keep fans advised as to the length of the delay in play; however, in the event of severe weather or lightning, avoid the following areas: bleachers, tall or isolated trees, hill tops or other high areas, open fields, golf carts, lakes and ponds, metal fences, barricades, hospitality venues, etc.

Mobility-Impaired Spectators

Parking for spectators with state-issued Blue parking hang-tags is located in the Red Lot. See ValsparChampionship.com for details. Special viewing platforms for spectators in wheelchairs are located at Hole #18. For the safety of all concerned, it is suggested that those using wheelchairs or similar transport use the hard-surfaced roads, cart paths and flat observation areas as much as possible. The grass is often damp and becomes very slippery on sloped areas. Limited on-course mobility shuttles will be available throughout the course.

Players

The players have until 5 p.m. EST on the Friday of the week preceding the tournament to officially commit to playing in the Valspar Championship. For an up-to-date list, please visit ValsparChampionship.com.

Youth Policy

Children ages 15 and under are admitted free of charge with a properly credentialed adult. Limit of six (6) children per adult. This excludes entrance to all hospitality areas and the Hooters Owl's Nest. Tickets required for anyone 10 years and older to access hospitality areas and the Hooters Owl's Nest.

Military Policy

Active or retired U.S. Military personnel receive free grounds admission and admission to the Pinch-A-Penny Patriots' Outpost hospitality tent at the 4th green. Veterans also receive a ticket discount Visit ValsparChampionship.com for details.

Rideshare

Rideshare drop-off and pick-up is located at the Green Lot on the corner of Belcher Road & Klosterman Road (Near Gate 4).

Bicycle Parking

The Valspar Championship is a bicycle-friendly tournament. Be more environmentally friendly and avoid riding the shuttles — ride your bicycle to the event! Bike racks will be provided at Gate 1 and Gate 4. Please note the tournament is not liable for any stolen or damaged items.

Mobile Device/Cellphone Policy

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use
- No livestreaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage) is permitted
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week
- · Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- · Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- · Failure to comply with this policy may result in revocation of your ticket

Lost & Found Items

Lost & Found will be located at the main Information tent near the 1st tee. Lost & Found items may be picked up prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day they are lost. All items not picked up prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day they are lost will be taken to the Will Call location at Palm Harbor Shops. To report or inquire about Lost & Found items, please call 727-942-5566.

Prohibited Items

- · No backpacks, seat cushions, or coolers of any kind
- No opaque bags larger than 6"x6"x6" (in their natural state)
- No clear tote bags, plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12"
- No chair bags (folding chairs are permitted, but the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No lawn or oversized chairs
- No pets except for service animals
- No video cameras at any time
- No cameras or GoPros after Wednesday (camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No selfie sticks
- No computers or laptops
- No whistles, horns or noisemakers
- No radios, televisions or other electronic noiseproducing items
- No signs, banners, poles or rods
- No alcoholic beverages may enter or leave the tournament
- No outside food or beverages may enter the tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No weapons of any kind may enter the tournament, including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- No fireworks or laser pointers
- No illegal substances
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials
- No memorabilia items, such as flags and photos

All items are subject to search. There is no check tent, so you will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

Autograph Policy

During official competitive rounds (Thursday - Sunday), a player cannot sign autographs after the start of his round until it is complete. The Tampa Bay Times Autograph Alley is located near the first tee/scoring area. Players have the option to use this area.

Suggested Attire

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only) is recommended. Spectators should have these items on hand: windbreaker, hat/visor. sunscreen, sunglasses and umbrella.
